- Each poster must include a top label indicating the title, the names of the authors, and their affiliations. Include straightforward "Introduction", "materials and methods", "Results" and "Conclusion" sections.
- Time allotted – 4 mins presentation and 2 mins discussion.
- Please note that as a presenter you have duty not to overshoot your time as you will end up encroaching others time slot.
